But, what does DOP/DEHP mean to your customer? As simply as we can state this, DOP/DEHP is a commonly known plasticizer from the phthalate ester family that has been used in flexible (PVC) products since the 1930's.

As phthalates (DOP/DEHP) have been used for such a long time, they continue to be closely studied to ensure their use is safe. It has been known for many years that small amounts of this type of plasticizer can leach out of products under certain circumstances.

Over the years, the World Health Organization's International Agency for Research on Cancer, the European Commission and the Centers for Disease Control have examined the effects of DOP/DEHP on humans. At this time, there is no evidence that anyone has been harmed by exposure to phthalate

(DOP/DEHP) plasticizers. Nevertheless, scientific uncertainty about the potential for phthalates (DOP/DEHP) to disrupt the human endocrine system or reproductive development has led to significant "on-going" debate about their safety. Today, more than eighty-six hospitals and group purchasing organizations (GPO's) in 12 states have pledged to reduce their use of PVC and/or DOP/DEHP. This number will grow significantly as the health care and food service markets seek the improved and healthier DOP/DEHP **FREE** gloves.

As 90% of the plasticizer still used is DOP/DEHP, there is a big disparity in price. Thus, the DOP/DEHP gloves are cheaper than the DOP/DEHP **FREE** gloves. However, as a recent Chinese trade report states, "...in America, DOP/DEHP is getting out of fashion and banned in some states. More states are likely to follow and therefore be careful if you are promoting cheaper DOP/DEHP gloves".
