Omni International is a multi-market glove supplier. Over the past year, we have experienced a growth in glove purchases. Everyone can agree, H1N1 influenza has enjoyed huge exposure in the media. In addition to H1N1 being real, glove purchases by our health care, dental and medical supply distributors has been "off the charts" for 2009. Due to high demand, and as we reported last month, raw material issues, obtaining medical grade gloves will continue to be challenging. As of this writing, Omni is holding its own in filling orders—though our vinyl and latex/nitrile factories have been moving back shipments due to increased world-wide demand. Jeph Fillion in our Logistics Department is spending many days and nights keeping Omni and distributor direct containers flowing as smooth as possible.

Consumer retail medical gloves are enjoying their strongest sales in years.

Our Food Service business has really skyrocketed. More usage by restaurant and supermarket employees due to influenza, salmonella and e-coli outbreaks has created excess demand in our Vinyl Factory, thus the addition of 21 new

manufacturing lines to meet current demand and allow for even more growth in our NSF and General food product line.

Speaking of "general", even this business sector is significantly up and could exceed projections in 2010 as well.

Whether the economy is good or not, we can honestly say that more people are donning gloves these days to protect us and themselves. We hope your glove business is up also and that you are receiving your fair share.
