Now What's Going On?

Aren't we all tired of the instability of availability and pricing when it comes to those 5 finger wonders we call gloves?

As we mentioned in our Omni Latex/Nitrile White Paper of several months ago, raw materials for synthetic latex have been in short supply. In addition to that, add:

- The fluctuating per barrel oil price (\$82.00 during the first week of January).
- Traditional flu epidemics
- The H1N1 influenza
- Bad weather affecting the natural latex yield
- Latex & Nitrile factories dealing with higher than normal increased demand
- Two factories with production issues (a fire at one –a flood at another)

and the glove industry has some major production situations today that they did not experience last year.

Most of the price and product availability have centered on nitrile and latex gloves. Many factories have been quick to increase price and slow on delivery.

If you remember, last year—the Olympics, cleaning up the Chinese air and oil prices over \$140.00 per barrel put the vinyl world in a tizzy. Though availability is not an issue on vinyl products, we are ever watching the daily barrel of oil pricing as that weighs so much on petroleum based products like vinyl.

The bad news...latex and nitrile production will be tight for the next six to seven months. Then there should be some relief...UNLESS of course, H1N1 rears it's ugly head again!

Omni is doing its best to keep ahead of the curve as we strive to maintain our distribution centers shelves.

We are noticing stronger than usual orders compared to last January and expect that the economic recovery is at least making a marginal rebound. However, with recovery comes an even stronger demand for gloves. With that in mind, remember that latex and nitrile will continue to be in shorter supply for the foreseeable future.
